In the great garden of life, Barbara Garro is a rare and precious flower in full bloom.

The vivacious Saratoga Springs entrepreneur believes every human has a green thumb when it comes to personal growth potential, and has written a book aptly titled *Grow Yourself A Life You'll Love*.

Whether you've got a naturally rosy disposition or are more of a shrinking violet, you're sure to sprout new emotional and spiritual blossoms as you work through exercises that will enable you to explore seeds (beliefs, assumptions and presumptions) that were planted in your subconscious mind long ago. Divided into three easy-to-read sections, Garro's book promises to "destroy the weeds that spoil your life," help you to "plant good seeds in fertile soil," and finally, to "harvest -- uniting body, mind and spirit."

Although the insightful and often humorous book just rolled off the presses this year, Garro spent nearly three decades cultivating the contents presented on its 233 pages.

At times the project was a "tough row to hoe", but Garro persevered until the right words and phrases found their way into the hands of the right publisher.

What made her write the book? "The seed for *Grow Yourself a Life You'll Love* was planted when I realized two pivotal concepts: (1) Love is all there is, and (2) The choices I make create my life."

Her opening words speak volumes. "When you understand why you are the way you are, you'll be kinder to yourself," asserts Garro in her introduction. "When you understand others better, you like them more and be less critical. This will help them like you more and make your life more harmonious. Think about how much better your life would be if you got along better with the love of your life, your parents, children, siblings, friends, co-workers and neighbors."

Were the author's own life a garden, it would be filled with a magnificent variety of flora and fauna. The president and CEO of Electric Envisions Inc. in Saratoga Springs, Garro is a seasoned personal growth coach and leader of motivational workshops. Born in Camden, New Jersey in 1943, Garro went on to study at the Philadelphia Art Museum in the early '60s and later earned a master of arts degree from State University of New York's Empire State College.

Prior to launching Electric Envisions, Garro paid her dues in corporate America, vowing to bring the best of what she had learned into her own company ... shaking the rest off her high heels so as not to contaminate her own corporate garden with destructive weeds.


